Brother Mac,

Please thank all the brethren who have been keeping Elelwane in their prayers - we all truly appreciate it Elelwane went home to her parents last weekend and they really climbed into her about the church of Christ. The short version of it is that they absolutely forbade her from ever attending our services again.

We picked her up on Wednesday evening and she told us that she was determined to attend services with the Lord's church.

However she sent me an message on my cell phone on Sunday morning (June 14, 2009) and said that she did not know what to do now because her parents instructed her older brother who also lives in our province to come to her apartment early Sunday mornings and make sure she attends their church by taking her there himself regardless of how she feels about the issue.

I wrote back and asked her if I should come over and talk to her brother but by the time we spoke to each other over the phone they were already on their way to their church.

I handed the phone to Sylvia and she spoke to Elelwane who could not properly communicate with Sylvia because Elelwane was already crying by then.

We promised to talk to her again and try to help her in whichever way we could - it is very difficult to break the traditional African hold parents have over their children especially girls.

Please continue to remember this young Christian woman in your prayers.

We spoke to her again the following week and she said that she told her parents that she would not be going back to that denomination. She has been attending faithfully at Brixton since. We do not know what her parents' next move will be but in the mean time we will just continue teaching and encouraging her to remain faithful to the Lord.
