

## **August 2008, Report**

Inflation worsened to 13.4% and prices remained high as well, implying that the cost of living has continued to worsen. Fueling my car is now almost impossible as the fuel prices fluctuate between abnormal price of \$1.67 per litre.

Poverty and death rates have also continued to threaten many lives even among those in the household of God.

But we are continuing to fix our eyes on HIM because He is the author and finisher of our faith.

### **Evangelism and Study.**

Because I was in Europe for part of the month, there were not much studies with potential converts. However there are new prospects whom I hope to study with in september 2008. your prayers are all welcome.

Rosemary has also continued to visit and study with a few women the word of God as well.

### **Lakeside Church**

The church remained very stable and the Lord has continued to help and strengthen us with HIS word.

We studied the story of Naomi and the way Ruth clung on her, choosing to identify with the culture of the children of God. Application here is that the saints ought to forsake their old cultures and adopt the cultures of the Kingdom of God and follow God's words.

We continue to remind the saints that eternal life is the reason they are Christians (1Tim 6:12).

### **Kampala Church**

We continued to study about evangelism and Acts 8 and the apostle Paul's commitment to the word of God were our care examples. Again, since trip to Holland took some half of the month, some subjects remained to addressed again in september.

The church has continued to prosper. The Lord has continued to encourage the saints with His word.

### **Tororo Church**

I squeezed time and visited Tororo church on Saturday 30th and encouraged them to continue steadfastly in the Lord. Ephesians 5 was my subject, but put special emphasis on Ephesians 5:15-16, (See then that you walk circumspectly not as fools but as wise, redeeming time because days are evil), and taking them back, we re-observed Ephesians 5:8 (for we were once darkness, but now we are light in the Light. Walk as children of the light). We were all encouraged with these words of the Lord.

### **Rosemary's contribution,**

Like always, Rosemary has continue to serve the Lord intensively among women and children.

I want to encourage everyone to keep praying for Rosemary for both spiritual and physical strength, to enable her continue teaching and helping women and children. Her labor cannot go unnoticed both before God and before men.

### **Challenges of the month**

We received support of \$1000 from Southside and Nick \$400 very early in the month, but the next support, \$200 came after 18th of the month. We had to pay rent and bills for the month as soon as the two early of the month support came, then children came back for holidays, transport costs, and I had to travel to Europe, ... everything was crowded and \$1400 was all we had for almost 3 weeks, yet Rosemary's family and my family both looked to that for upkeep and the Lord's work adding to already existing biting poverty. Sorry to say, but we went through financial pain like never before, but we give thanks to God for everything, especially that we are still HIS children, while we lack or while we have. Please continue praying for us because some of these circumstances break us at times.
