Also a man named Carlos Blanco visited us regularly; he seems to belong to a denominational group, as he told us he had been baptized to receive Christ. But by means of the teachings he has received he has begun to have doubts about the validity of his baptism.

We are content because during this year the growth of the work has been obvious in this locality, as well as in other places in the interior of the country. Here 6 souls were converted to the Lord and I have a group of 5 persons that are receiving Bible teaching. There is also another group of contacts of other brethren here.
