On Tuesday afternoons, in the company of Javier Alvarez (the preacher at the new congregation in Caracas) I went out to give out tracts, put up flyers inviting people to study the Bible on the walls, preaching, etc.

On Wed. afternoons I met with Brother Jose Ramon, so that we can study the Bible together. He has only been baptized a few months and asked me to study with him.

On Sat. the 11th a group of 7 brethren went out to preach the Word and pass out flyers inviting people to study the Bible.

I have 2 new contacts—two ladies, one named Berta and the other named Maria. Berta came to know the church some years ago through an aunt, but it wasn't important to her at the time—she was young, but now has a lot of interest in studying. Maria knows some knowledge of the Bible, but with the errors of those called "evangelicals" (think Pentecostals). Thanks to God I have been able to help her clear up various things.

Luisa is another contact I have been studying with for 3 months and she has begun to attend our Sunday services. She visited us the whole month of Feb. and what makes this so important is that she has not returned to the denominational church she was attending. She herself told me that she feels she has found the true church. (She was baptized about a week ago)

On Sunday the 19th I was invited to preach in the church that began meeting that day in Palo Verde, this is in the Eastern part of the city of Caracas. They meet at 3 PM.

I continue my visits with other contacts that I have to study and encourage them.
