

REPORT FOR NOVEMBER 2007

December 4, 2007

On Sundays and Wednesdays I participated in all aspects of the worship service and Bible study, including the teaching and preaching.

On Sunday the 18th (in the afternoon) my wife and I visited with the church in Palo Verde, to say goodbye to Brother Gregory Roark, who was leaving the next day for the USA, to see his family. Counting her, we now have 4 members who have come from other congregations to place membership with us. Her name is Jenny.
